Bill Summary:

Requires a license for the operation of any amusement device. Defines "amusement device" as a device or combination of devices or elements that carry, convey or direct a person over or through a fixed or restricted course or within a defined area for the primary purpose of amusement or entertainment, including but not limited to bungee jumping, water slides and hayrides. **The definition of an "amusement device" includes things such as a water slide, which could affect aspects of the pool and spa industry, looking for input from those members who may be affected.**

Status:

Recommended "ought to pass as amended" on May 4, but the amended text is not yet available.
