HB 777 - Public Health Code

Affects:

Those who manufacturer or sell isolation float tanks.

Bill Summary:

Exempts isolation float tanks from the public swimming pool laws, clarifies that they can be used when prescribed by a physical therapist. This follows what was clarified in the recent ISPSC hearings that these float tanks are not considered swimming pools and therefore, are not bound by requirements for pools and spas.

Status:

Passed the House by 118-0 vote on April 28 and now in the Senate Rules & Operations Committee.

HB 97 - TAX (ENVIRONMENTAL INCENTIVES)

Affects:

Those who manufacturer or install solar pool heating systems.

Bill Summary:

Extends the sunset on the renewable energy property credit through January 1, 2018. Appears that the renewable energy property tax credit being applies to solar pool heating as well.

Therefore, if this bill were signed into law it would provide a property tax credit for someone installing solar pool heating system.

Status:

Passed House by 93-23 vote on May 22. Referred to the following Senate Committees on May 26: Committee on Appropriations and Base Budget; Committee on Finance; and Committee on Pensions and Retirement and Aging.
