Proclamation

WHEREAS, NEW MEXICANS ARE AWARE OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY THE ORGANIZATIONS INVOLVED IN THE NATIONAL WATER SAFETY MONTH COALITION TO DEVELOP SAFE SWIMMING FACILITIES, AQUATIC PROGRAMS, AND RELATED ACTIVITIES, AND TO EDUCATE THE PUBLIC ON SAFETY ISSUES; AND
