WHEREAS, Wyoming recognizes the importance of educating the public on pool and spa safety and related initiatives by the pool, spa, waterpark and recreation industries; and

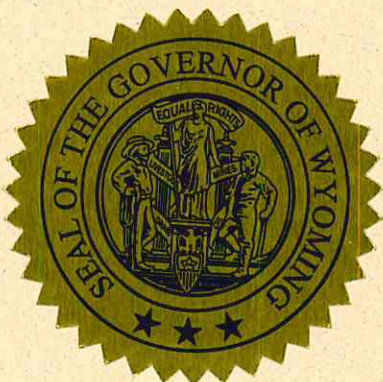
